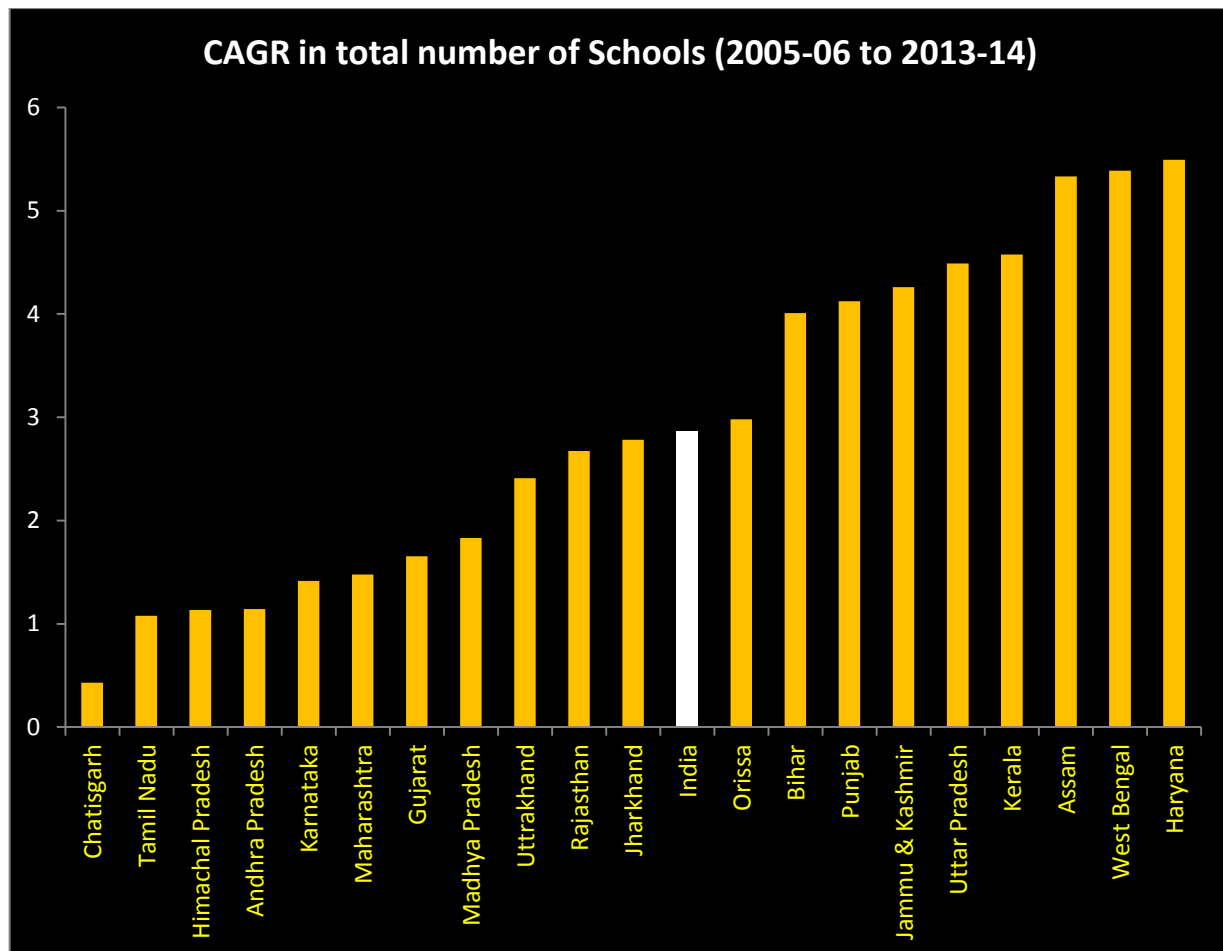


The growth (CAGR) in number of schools across India stood 3% (approx.) although there are variations among different states. Haryana (5.49), West Bengal (5.39) and Assam (5.33) are to top three states respectively and Chhattisgarh (0.43), Tamil Nadu (1.08) and Himachal Pradesh (1.13) have performed humbly in this regard. Lower CAGR in some of the bigger states may have been resulted due to the saturation level.
